Sylantro Demonstrates First Best-of-Breed Integration of Enhanced VOIP Services with Yahoo! Messenger for Business and Consumer Markets

SOAP Interface Available to Sylantro's Service-Provider Customers and Third-Party Developers Demonstrates Flexibility and Extensibility of Sylantro's Open Standards-Based Feature Server

SUPERCOMM 2004, CHICAGO, June 22, 2004 – Sylantro Systems Corporation today announced the unveiling of the industry's first open standards-based integration of telecommunications services with Yahoo! Messenger 6.0 at SUPERCOMM 2004. Yahoo! (NYSE: YHOO) Messenger is one of the most widely used instant messaging services in the world with over 40 million users. Using Sylantro's developer's kit and the Yahoo! open presence interface, service providers can quickly develop and deploy integrated hosted voice services with Yahoo! Messenger or other best-of-breed instant messaging clients for residential and business users.

Sylantro has integrated IP telephony capabilities such as click-to-call, call logs, visual voice mail and find me/follow me with Yahoo! Messenger, allowing users to control and use their hosted communications services through the ubiquitous instant messaging (IM) interface. Further, the integrated Sylantro capabilities offer presence information for contacts that are also Yahoo! Messenger users, giving users additional options in their communications.

"Progressive integration of voice, mobility and instant messaging is an important step in the evolution of communications, and our focus on open and published interfaces enables rapid and rich integrations with other network elements and services," said David Illing, senior vice president of marketing and business development for Sylantro Systems. "The Yahoo! open presence interface, integrated with Sylantro's enhanced VoIP services, offers compelling new end-user functionality."

Using the integrated Sylantro capabilities, users can click-to-call or click-to-IM from a list of missed or incoming calls depending on the contact's presence indication or the user's preference. Advanced hosted communications features, such as find me/follow me and privacy settings, can be set up or changed with just a few mouse clicks.

The Sylantro/Messenger integration utilizes the Microsoft® .NET Framework, which has achieved wide distribution and usage both inside and outside the telecommunications industry. The .NET Framework allows integration with, and interworking between applications using Web services. Sylantro was the first developer in the hosted communications market to adopt SOAP (Simple Object Access Protocol), one of the components of the .NET Framework, and has since developed a number of .NET-based applications including a soft-attendant console, a user interface that is fully integrated into Microsoft Outlook®, a browser toolbar for hosted communications services, and other tools. .NET-based applications require no reconfiguration of firewalls or networks, allowing these applications to be deployed quickly and easily in business or consumer offerings.
